Dear Parish Family,

Saturday, June 29, is the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. As most of you know, on June 29, 1975, 49 years ago, Fr. Jim Farrell and I were ordained in St. Peter's Square by Pope Paul VI, who is now a canonized saint. Saturday is also the thirteenth anniversary of Archbishop Thompson's ordination as a bishop.

Because I plan to leave for vacation on Friday, June 28, I will celebrate my anniversary at the 5:30 p.m. Mass on Wednesday, June 26.

Next weekend, June 29-30, Fr. Jim Bonke will be the celebrant and homilist at the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass. Fr. Bonke is a retired priest of the Archdiocese who served as Defender of the Bond at the Tribunal. Fr. Bonke will also hear confessions on Saturday. Fr. Jim Farrell will be the celebrant and homilist at the Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass. Fr. Rick Ginther will be the celebrant and homilist at the Sunday 6:00 p.m. Mass. Fr. Rick is the pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes. He was associate pastor here from 1983-1985.

The following weekend, July 6-7, Fr. Jim Farrell will be the celebrant and homilist at the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass and the Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass. Fr. Farrell will also hear confessions on Saturday. Fr. Rick Ginther will be the celebrant and homilist at the Sunday 6:00 p.m. Mass.

This Monday, June 24, is the Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist.

Tuesday, June 25, is the anniversary of the death of Fr. Jerome Pfau, the second pastor of Little Flower. Fr. Pfau died in 1957. Wednesday, June 26, is the anniversary of the death of Bishop Simon Bruté, the first bishop of the Diocese of Vincennes, which included Indianapolis. He died in 1839.

Friday, June 28, is the feast of St. Irenaeus, bishop and martyr. St. Irenaeus wrote that the Son of God became what we are that he might make us what he is himself. In other words, the Son of God became human that he might make us who are human what he is himself, i.e., sons and daughters of God.


