If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

#### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

#### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.



Next Saturday please welcome Fr. Nick Dant who will hear confessions and be the celebrant and homilist for the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass. While he was pastor at Our Lady of Lourdes, Fr. Nick lived in the rectory here at Little Flower. When he left Our Lady of Lourdes, he became pastor of St. Matthew Parish. He is now retired.

On Saturday, August 3, my brother is hosting a combined birthday celebration for his wife who will turn 70 on July 31, his daughter Caity who will turn 36 on August 5, his grandson Oskar who will turn 9 on August 18, and me who will turn 75 on August 6. Every year on the first Saturday of August, family and friends of David C. O'Connor return to Little Flower to remember him and all veterans at the 5:00 p.m. Mass. David, a parishioner and member of the LF Class of 1962, was killed in action in Viet Nam 55 years ago on August 2, 1969. For his service to our country, David was awarded four Purple Hearts. The National Eucharistic Congress was a wonderful event for our Archdiocese and the Church in the United States. Several people have told me that they ran into parishioners who they did not know were attending. I think it would be good for the parish to have some record of all who attended from Little Flower. Monday is the feast of Sts. Mary, Martha, and Lazarus. In 2021, Pope Francis added St. Mary and Lazarus to what had been the feast of St. Martha. At their home, Jesus experienced family and friendship.

Wednesday we celebrate the Feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola, Priest. St. Ignatius was the founder of the Jesuits. According to the Ordo, at the time of his death in 1556, "the Society numbered 1000 members in seventy-six houses in twelve provinces, including Brazil, Japan, and India; today numbers some 14,840 members...." In Indianapolis, Brebeuf High School is a ministry of the Jesuits. My first three years in Rome I attended the Pontifical Gregorian University, a Jesuit university.

Thursday is the feast of St. Alphonsus Liquori, bishop and doctor of the Church. St. Alphonsus was a lawyer who founded the Redemptorists. He was one of the greatest moral theologians in the history of the Church. Cardinal Tobin is a member of the Redemptorists.


