SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Today is the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time. In 2019, Pope Francis designated the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time as the Sunday of the Word of God.

Our school open house is this Sunday, January 26, from 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. We invite ALL parishioners, but especially the parents of young children, to come and see the great work that is taking place in your school. If you have school-age children, please consider what a Little Flower Catholic education can provide your children. If you have friends or family, please invite them to visit. Come and meet our teachers, tour the building, and share in the successes of your parish school.

Likewise, I would encourage all of you to be ambassadors for Little Flower School throughout the year. Please invite friends or neighbors with preschool-age children and/or grade-school-age children who are searching for a school for their children to contact Little Flower School to make an appointment to visit.

Appropriately, this week the Church celebrates three saints who were educators of young people. These three saints demonstrate how important Catholic schools and education have been in the life and mission of the Church.

Monday is the feast of St. Angela Merici. St. Angela Merici founded the Ursulines, the first teaching Order especially for poor young girls. She sought the re-evangelization of families through the education of future wives and mothers.

Tuesday is the feast of St. Thomas Aquinas, priest and doctor of the Church. St. Thomas Aquinas, theologian and philosopher, is the patron saint of Catholic schools. He is the author of the *Summa Theologiae* and the author of the hymns *Adoro te devote*, *O Salutaris*, *Tantum ergo*, and *Pange Lingua*.

Friday is the feast of St. John Bosco, an educator. St. John Bosco is known as the Apostle of Youth. He founded the Salesian Order which is dedicated to educating youth. He was also a pioneer in vocational education. CYO's highest award for youth volunteers is the St. John Bosco medal.

Monday, February 3, is the feast of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr. Because St. Blaise saved a choking child, he is the patron saint for healing diseases of the throat, and, therefore, the blessing of throats is associated with the feast of St. Blaise. The blessing of throats will be incorporated into the final blessing at Mass next weekend, February 1 and 2. Throats will be individually blessed during the 5:30 p.m. Mass on Monday, February 3, and at 9:30 a.m. All-School Mass on Friday, February 7.

Arts and Environment Ministry Chair Needed



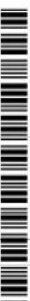

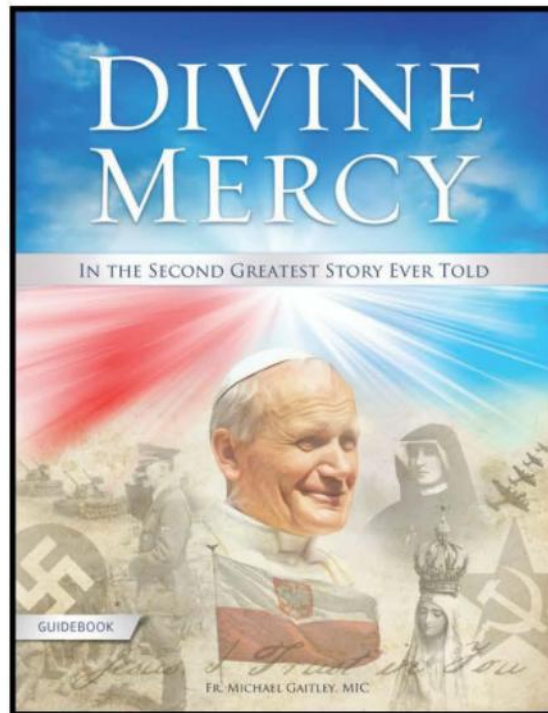
